Project Warmth Helped Over 2000 Families in the 2023-2024 Winter Season

Including: 1,468 children, 1,063 seniors, 106 veterans and 2,580 adults.

- 81% required heating assistance because of a medical emergency, illness or disability.
- 19% needed help because of a loss of job or loss of a loved one.
- 92% had at least one vulnerable person in the house. Elders, young children and individuals with disabilities are most susceptible to extreme temperatures and prioritized by Project Warmth.
- 100% required assistance due to a disruption in family income.
